Remarks on autumn and spring activities and hibernation of tree frogs

Three tree frogs (Hyla~arborea) called in a garden until the 16^{th} of October and hibernated most obviously in a stack firewood in about 1 m height. Calling of the three specimens started in spring at the 23^{rd} of March. In early April the calling males migrated southwards to the spawning ponds. In two years an iron fence pale were used as calling place and functioned as amplifier.

Winter activity of Portuguese snakes (additional remarks)

During a two-week excursion in November 2007 in southern Portugal (prov. Algarve, Baixo Alentejo) six species of snakes could be observed in activity: $Hemorrhois\ hippocrepis$, $Malpolon\ monspessulanus$, $Rhinechis\ scalaris$, $Coronella\ girondica$, $Natrix\ maura$, $Natrix\ natrix\ astreptophora$. The excursion was accompanied by extreme favourable weather conditions, free of precipitation and with temperatures up to +26 °C.
